What is APTA?




- Principal public transportation trade organization, with more than 1,500 transit, business, and other members in the United States, Canada, and worldwide.










Public Transportation Use Growing Faster Than Highway Use (2005 – 2012)

- 42% of trips taken on rail.
- 5% on other modes.

1.95 more riders from 2011 to 2012




High Speed Rail is Coming





5 Mega Regions – 150+ projects






APTA -

\$57 billion industry; directly employs more than 400,000 people; supports 2 million public and private sector jobs.










